	4. Evaluate/order supply of protective equipment: gloves, masks, face/eye shields.	Resources: BoundTree.com
	5. Conduct Health Screenings for both staff and campers that includes screening for communicable disease	Health Screening Example Form (campnurse.org)
	6. Identify CDP Team responsible for critical services & conduct training prior to start of camp.	Camp Director/Coordinator, spokesperson, Health center lead, food service liaison, business manager, facilities
	7. Define Tipping Point for Launching CDP Interventions	Number of Ill or % of ill persons within a determined time frame
	8. Define Isolation capabilities & criteria for sending home	Place isolation information in staff manual and parent policies
	9. Contact appropriate insurance and local EMS personnel	Communicate camp's practices and capacity
	10. Consult local officials regarding regional quarantine guidelines and outbreak control measures

	12. Maintain access to resources	Heymann – Control of Communicable Disease Manual CDC website (cdc.gov) Membership to ACN/ACA Community Resources – Public health dept
	13. Conduct daily review of health log	Identify communicable disease hot spots in need of monitoring or intervention
INTERVENTION	ACTIVITIES	TOOLS/CONSIDERATIONS
Outbreak Occurs	1. Convene meeting of CDP Team.	Daily Meetings once Outbreak occurs – revisit processes daily.
	2. Identify symptoms and illness as soon as possible.	Consult with medical provider & provide ongoing updates during the outbreak.
	3. Identify key health services support needs	Staffing, isolation arrangements, supplies, prevention of cross-contamination, care for well staff & campers, medication management, documentation.
	4. Food services	Meals/Nutrition plans for III campers and caretakers; augment menu as needed to keep folks healthy.
	5. Communication plans	Spokesperson(s) for families, media, public health dept, insurance, unaffected campers/staff, collect/save documentation of communication
	6. Facilities	Access to separate toilet and hand-washing facilities; emptying trash; ventilation/climate control; transportation, laundry service

RECOVERY/MITIGATION	ACTIVITIES	TOOLS/CONSIDERATIONS
Resolution	1. CDP Team Evaluation	Provide critical incident debriefing Review all operational activities to determine effectiveness and identify potentials for change; update policy/procedures.
	2. Documentation	Confirm completion of documentation by all required individuals – health center staff, spokesperson(s), camp director, business manager, insurance carrier.
	3. Debrief Camp & facilitate return- to-routine camp practices.	Listen to experiences of all staff and campers who wish to share experience. Allow time for staff rest and recuperation.
	4. Update/revise staff, parent and camper materials to more effectively address CDP.
