

Alliance for Camp Health Research Collaboration Process

(Updated March 2017)

The Alliance for Camp Health (ACH) supports research that promotes positive experiences and health promotion in the camp environment. Proposals that (a) support the mission of the ACH and (b) benefit the camp community will be considered.

- 1. Read the "Research Collaboration Agreement" document.
- 2. Complete a project proposal & submit it to the ACH research committee at <u>bgarst@clemson.edu</u>. (No more 1,000 words)
 - Project overview- theoretical background, hypotheses & methods
 - Collaboration type- Describe the type of support that's requested from ACH (e.g., collaboration; access to member email addresses, data sharing, etc.)
 - Project deliverables
 - Project budget (particularly if funds are being requested through ACH's research seed grant process)
 - Project timeline
 - Project dissemination
- 3. Proposal is reviewed by ACH's Research Committee and/or the Board and the applicant is notified of acceptance or denial.
- 4. "Research collaboration Agreement" submitted for accepted proposals.
- 5. "Project Coordinator" and proposal number assigned
- 6. Submission of draft for review
- 7. Receive feedback from project coordinator
- 8. Research collected & analysis completed
- 9. Report of findings submitted to ACH
- 10. Dissemination of results
